Payment:

- Payment for lessons are due at the beginning of the month.
- Cheques to be payable to Victory Time Farm Therapeutic Riding Inc.
- We also accept on-line bank transfer to Victorytimefarm@yahoo.ca or Visa & Master Card.

Cancellations:

- We require 24 hours cancellation for lessons.
- If 24 hours is provided, a make up lesson will be assigned.
- If less than 24 hours is provided, a \$10.00 cancellation fee is required and a make up lesson assigned.
- In the case of inclement weather we will make every effort to advise students in advance, that we are unable to ride. We will make every effort to re-schedule at a time agreeable to both rider and coach.

Clothing and Apparel:

- If you require assistance with getting the proper apparel, please ask us
- We request that all students provide their own approved riding helmet.
- Boots with a heel must be used when riding (rubber boots are acceptable).
- Please ensure that you are wearing proper footwear at all times. (No sandals, or flip-flops.)

General:

- Unfortunately our insurance does not provide for visitor dogs at the farm.
- Please remember that horses are large, live animals, and you have a responsibility to conduct yourself in a calm, safe manner at the barn.
- We encourage students to apply for an Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF) membership. It is important for your own safety in case of injuries. OEF offers highly beneficial insurance coverage. Please see www.horse.on.ca
